
Hire of the Cathedral facilities

The Cathedral

An attractive entrance lobby leads through to the beautiful modern cathedral church.



The large fan shaped auditorium, with pews seating 750 (we can accommodate up to 1000 with additional seating at the sides and rear of the cathedral) slopes down to the altar with no internal separation or supports to restrict the view and with under-floor heating. Two V-shaped multipurpose open spaces are elevated from and project into the seating area and are suitable for use by the disabled. The Cathedral is fully wheelchair accessible with ramps into the building, and disabled toilet facilities.



The acoustics in the church are excellent, making this an ideal venue for concerts and, with permission the cathedral's pipe organ and piano can be used at an additional charge. A loop system is also available for the hard of hearing. Separate male, female and disabled toilet facilities are available and there is plentiful free car parking adjacent to the cathedral.



The attached hall has a good view into the main cathedral through a large window and is linked to the church's PA system, so whatever is happening in the cathedral can be heard as well as seen. Organisations hiring the cathedral should respect that the church is used for religious worship.

The Hall

The hall is newly refurbished with a wooden floor. It is a well-lighted room, (approximately 9.4m x 13.5m [126.9m²], with a height of approximately 3.2m) with tables and chairs, comfortably seating 100 people and can accommodate 150 people standing. The hall has its own access doors and is equipped with a large electric rolling screen (approximately 2.4m x 1.8m) and an overhead digital projector with DVD player, Freeview box and facilities to connect a computer. This is connected to speakers around the hall, giving good audio quality throughout. The toilet facilities are adjacent to the hall.



The Kitchen

There is a well equipped kitchen (two ovens, eight rings and a microwave, water boiler, fridge freezer and a dishwasher) with a hatch through to the hall. Crockery, glasses, cutlery and tablecloths can also be hired for an additional contribution.
